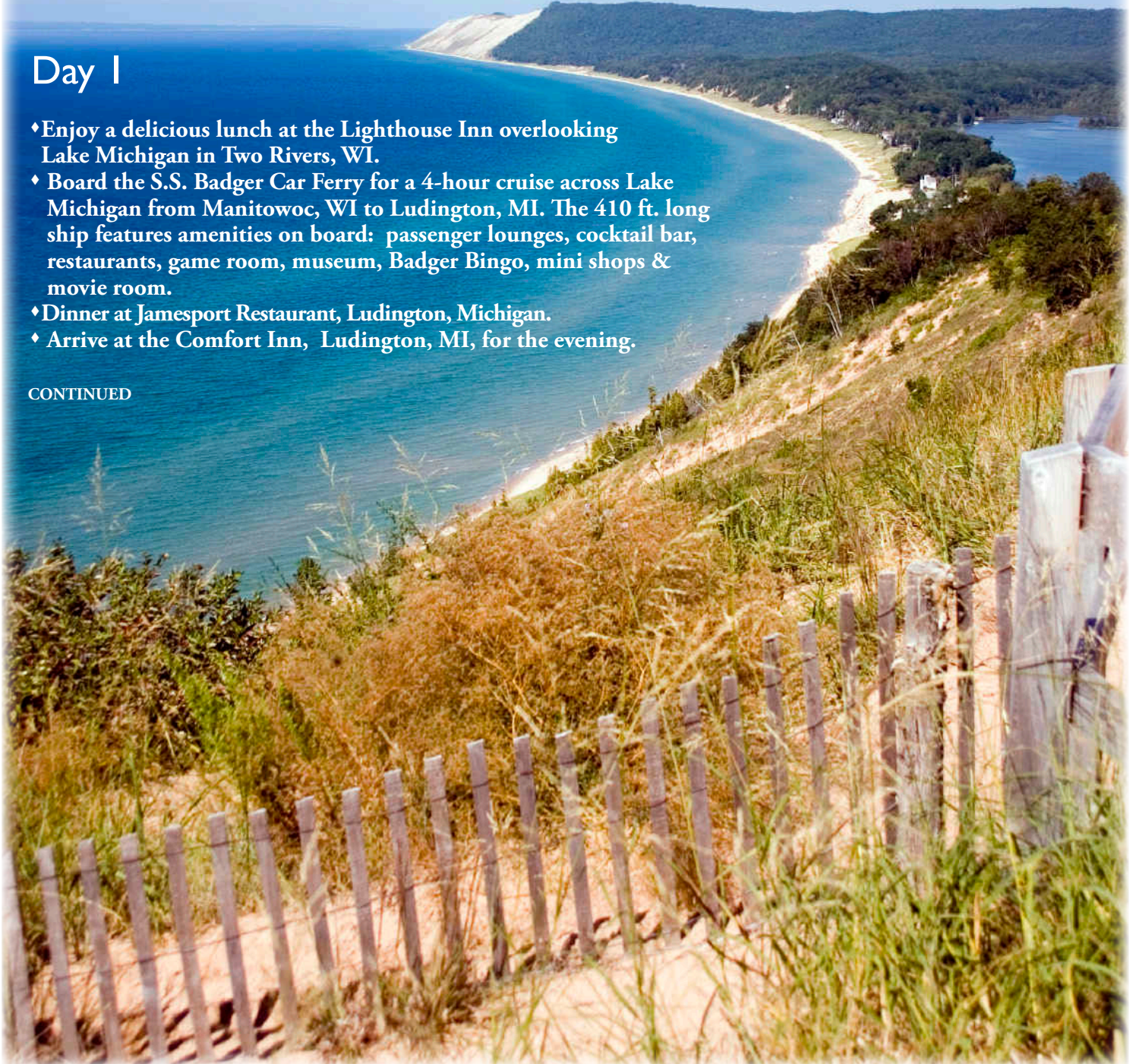


SS Badger Ferry Across Lake Michigan, Dunes, Blueberries & TreeMendous Fruit Farm
